

ARE YOU PREPARED?

Truckee Police and Truckee Fire have joined Nevada County in using the CodeRED Emergency Alert System as the primary method of communication during critical incidents. They will send texts and emails directly to your wireless device or email account during an emergency or for evacuation messaging.

In an emergency, public safety officials will use multiple messaging tools to communicate information and instructions to the community. Your local cable and satellite stations along with AM and FM radio may broadcast updated information. Know what messaging tools our community uses before the emergency occurs.

KNOW YOUR EVACUATION ZONE

In order to understand whether your area is under an evacuation warning or order, you need to know your Zone Name. Authorities will use Zone Names in emergency alerts, media releases and social media to notify residents what areas are under an evacuation warning or order.

1. Go to community.zonehaven.com
2. Enter your address into the search bar.
3. Find your Zone in the pop-up window and write it down.

HAVE A PLAN

- Have a plan for how you will leave and where you will go
- Talk to your family or the people you are with about what you will do
- Have a go bag with three days of clothing, medications, supplies and important paperwork
- If you have a vehicle, make sure the fuel tank is full
- If you don't have a vehicle, have a plan for how you will leave
- Take your kids and pets with you. Once you evacuate, you cannot come back
