


NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on the date and time indicated below to receive and consider the statements of all persons who wish to be heard relative to this application.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Planning Division has received an application for Soaring Ranch Phase 3, a mixed-use development with 7,834 sq. ft. of retail floor area and 109 multifamily residential units (91 market-rate units and 18 affordable housing units) located at 10701 Soaring Way (APN 019-620-067-000). The project site is located in the CR (Regional Commercial) zoning district of the Joerger Ranch Specific Plan.

The following land use entitlements are required for the proposed project: **1) Development Permit** for projects that involve new non-residential structure(s) with 7,500 square feet or more of total gross floor area, 26,000 square feet or more of site disturbance and/or 11 or more multi-family residential units; **2) Planned Development Amendment** to revise the overall Soaring Ranch site plan to integrate the Phase 3 mixed-use development; **3) Use Permit** to allow for multi-family residential units in the CR (Regional Commercial) zoning district at a density of 12 dwelling units per acre, consistent with the General Plan and Joerger Ranch Specific Plan, and to permit an accessory daycare use as a residential amenity for the tenants; and **4) Zoning Clearance** to permit 7,834 sq. ft. of retail space in the CR zoning district.

ENVIRONMENTAL STATUS: Concurrent with adoption of the Joerger Ranch Specific Plan, the Town certified an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) in March 2015. The EIR identified the range of environmental impacts associated with buildout of the Specific Plan and required implementation of mitigation measures to address and minimize these impacts. Staff has determined that no further environmental review is required pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15183 (Projects Consistent with a Community Plan, General Plan or Zoning), and Public Resources Code Section 21166 and CEQA Guidelines Section 15162 (Lead agency prohibition to require subsequent reports for a certified project unless specific events occur).
